

February 8, 2022 - COVID-19 Community Updates

We have good news to report! As a result of prior rigorous testing of residents and staff, coupled with the successful turnout of our vaccination clinics, continued on-going resident/staff screenings and strict compliance with multiple Long Beach Public Health directives, we have been clear of COVID in our community.

We will continue to test all of our staff & residents on a weekly basis while still maintaining all other strict protocols. If a resident or staff exhibits any symptoms, they will be tested immediately by our private lab.

Communal Dining

We are happy to announce that communal dining will begin this week in our dining room for residents who are not on isolation or under quarantine.

- There will be limited number of seats at each table with at least six feet between each resident.
- We will continue to remind Residents to wear facial coverings while not eating
- In-Room Complimentary Tray service will still be provided to the resident upon request

Visitation Policy

We are now transitioning our patio visits to socially distanced courtyard visitations! We are encouraging all families to call and schedule visits with the front desk Receptionist.

Any visitor entering the facility, regardless of their vaccination status, must adhere to the following:

- Be screened for fever and COVID-19 symptoms, wear appropriate facial covering, and perform hand hygiene when in the facility.
- Socially distance 6ft and remain in the courtyard area
- Visitors of Residents in private rooms are able to visit in the room with proof of vaccination, and Negative Covid PCR test within the last 48 hours or rapid test within the last 24 hours at time of visit.
- Visitors of residents in shared rooms are allowed to visit residents socially distanced within the courtyard. Visitors must still provide proof of vaccination, and Negative Covid PCR test within the last 48 hours or rapid test within the last 24 hours at time of visit.

Activities

We are happy to announce that social distanced activities will begin this week in the Courtyard, Library, Movie Room, & Activities room.

• There will be limited number of seats, but we will work diligently to ensure that all residents continuously stay active and present for gatherings. If families have any special request, please inform reception at the front desk.
